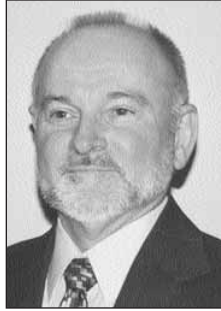

Sheff announces run for state legislature

Palermo resident, Peter M. Sheff, has announced his intention to seek the House Legislature seat in District 45 representing the towns of Palermo, Montville, Freedom, Knox, Thorndike, Troy and Burnham. Sheff's primary focus will be on reducing the size and scope of state government.

"Until we reduce the size and scope of our state government we cannot expect the cost of government and hence our taxes to be reduced," he said. "We are currently ranked 47th as the highest taxed state in the nation. Let's set a goal that in ten years we will be one of the lowest taxed states." Believing that the high cost of education discriminates against home owners in the form of ever increasing property taxes, one of his priorities will be in securing a more efficient, less expensive

21st century vision for educating our children.

"Our senior citizens are especially hit hard when they see their fixed incomes being depleted due to the high cost of education which represents approximately 60-80 percent of our property taxes," he said. He added, "Until we overcome the liberal stranglehold that has been in power in Augusta for the past several decades, nothing will much change in our state for the better. My goal is not only to be elected District 45 Representative, but help all republican candidates seize the political momentum that is screaming out 'Enough is

Enough' to liberal policies that have contributed to the current economic downturn and in preventing its recovery."

Sheff has worked in the financial sector over the past 10 years while also ministering at a local congregation of interdenominational believers. His political experience is limited to helping candidates run for statewide offices in Florida, North Carolina, and Alaska. He is currently one of five tax assessors in the town of Palermo.
