NOTICE OF TAX SALE
The Board of Selectmen of the Town of Vassalboro, Maine is accepting bids for the purchase of the municipality's interest in one tax-acquired property. Each bid must be in writing and in a sealed envelope marked "Tax sale bid" on the outside. All bids must be received at the Vassalboro Town Office no later than 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, June 23, 2010. Late bids will not be opened or considered.

The minimum bid price has been set by the Board of Selectmen at \$10,000.00. Each bid must also include the bidder's name, mailing address and phone number and must be accompanied by a deposit in the form of a certified check or money order, in an amount equal to or greater than 10% of the bid price. The successful bidder's deposit will

be credited to the total purchase price for the property. Deposits will be returned to the unsuccessful bidders. Any bid which does not contain the proper deposit will be rejected.

Bids will be opened, reviewed and possibly awarded by the Selectmen at the Town Office on Thursday, June 24, 2010 at 7:00 p.m. The Board of Selectmen reserves the right to reject any and all bids. The successful bidder shall have fourteen days from the date of the bid acceptance in which to complete the purchase. The property will be conveyed by a quitclaim deed without covenants. In the event that a successful bidder fails, for any reason, to complete the purchase in the time stated, the bid acceptance is void and the bidder's deposit shall be forfeited to the Town. The Board of Selectmen

may thereafter negotiate a sale of the property with any or all unsuccessful bidders.

The property for sale is described on the Town Tax Maps as: Map 006, Lot 002. A bid packet containing the tax maps and other public information concerning the property may be picked up at the Town Office during its normal business hours, which are: Monday through Wednesday, 8:00 am to 5:00 p.m.; Thursday, 8:00 am to 6:30 pm; and Friday, 8:00 am to noon. The tax maps can also be viewed on the town's website at www.vassalboro.net.
