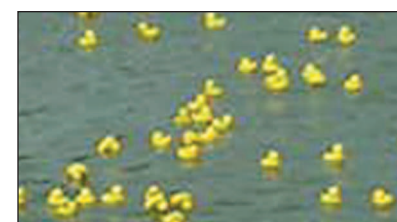

the flock, boosting the competitor ranks to a record 500 duckies battling for the coveted title of Champion Ducky.

Best view for the race is the finish line, which is the Damariscotta/Newcastle bridge. Spectators should gather for a 12:30 p.m. launch time, but should be prepared with patience, as the launch is contingent on the turning of the tide and may be up to 30 minutes later than expected. Ducky-related music and activities are planned at the bridge to entertain spectators as they await the start of the race. Bright yellow attire and all things 'ducky' are suggested. Each ducky is numbered, and each ticket sold corresponds to one ducky entry in the race. Tickets are 1 for \$5.00 or \$25.00 for a '6-Quack' and are on sale in Damariscotta at the PWA office (above Salt Bay Café) and Yellowfront Grocery; at the Round Pond Parade, outside the Maine Coast Book Shop on Wednesdays and Saturdays until race day; and at the Damariscotta-Newcastle bridge from 10 a.m. - noon on race day.

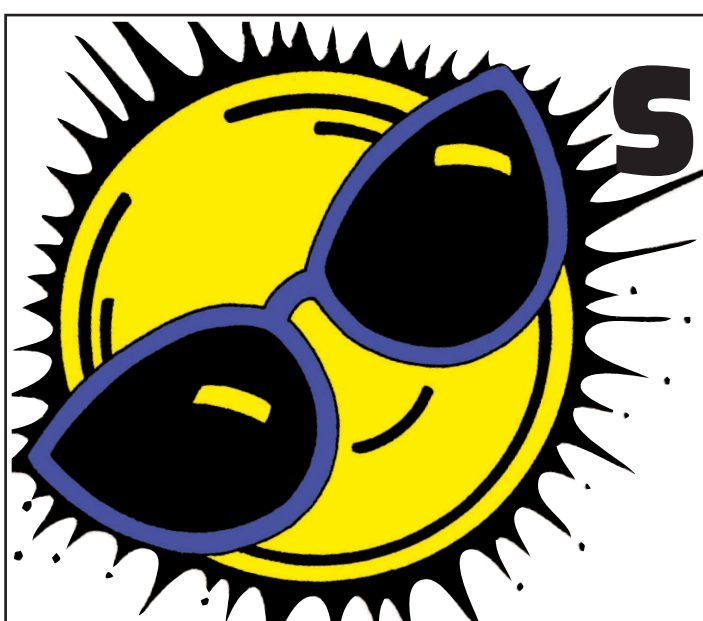
